In light of the current COVID-19 situation, every attempt will be made to minimize the risks of exposure to the virus. Situations are subject to change with little or no notice.

Ultimately, it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on-track and off, and to make the decision on whether or not to participate. If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath please stay home. If you have been in contact with someone who has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

While on site please take the health and safety of your fellow participants, volunteers and staff into consideration and practice social distancing, wear a mask, and wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently. Currently Ohio defines social distancing as a distance of not less than 6 feet and no groups greater than 10 people.

General:-

1. This event is governed by the 2020 SCCA General Competition Rules (GCR) and "FastTrack" effective October 1, 2020 release and these supplemental regulations.
2. This is a Northeast Divisional Road Racing Championship Event for 2021. Series rules for series classes can be found at www.nediv.com.
3. This event will be open to all drivers holding a valid SCCA membership & licensed per GCR 3.1.2 of 2020 GCR. Registrar not able to verify licenses issued by other clubs, you will be responsible to provide current license.

Entry Fee - Includes 3 crew passes (no additional passes will be available): (Prior to 10/16 & After 10/17)

Both Days: \$350 / \$395 One Day only: \$200 / \$225 Both days events (1 car, 1 driver, 2 classes): \$550 SRF,

SRF3, FE, FE2/race compliance fee/ weekend \$30

4. LATE FEE POLICY – There will be a late entry fee of \$50 assessed to all entries received once registration opens at the track. This is a rule that was implemented by Great Lakes Division in 2018.
5. In order to keep the entry fee down trophies may be distributed after the event. Make sure the Race Chair has your contact info.
6. Drivers and Entrants are responsible for their crew.
7. Everyone entering a HOT area must be an SCCA member and must wear the valid HOT credential issued for this event. Weekend SCCA memberships will be available at Registration for a cost of \$15.00.
8. DRONES AT THE RACE TRACK - Commercial Unmanned Aircraft System (aka "Drone") owners/operators must have proof of FAA certification and \$10M of primary liability insurance naming the SCCA, the Sponsoring Region(s) and the Race Track as additional insured. A general liability insurance policy must specify that it includes the operation of Unmanned Aircraft. Recreational use of unmanned aircraft is prohibited.
9. Mahoning Valley & Neohio SCCA strive to ensure that ALL participants in their events and activities enjoy a welcoming environment. We support equality of opportunity and treatment for all participants and will make every effort to maintain an environment that is free of harassment, discrimination, and any behavior that interferes with a safe, fun, and exciting experience. A commitment to a welcoming environment and the SCCA Values is expected of all its members and attendees, including drivers, workers, crew, guests, staff, contractors and exhibitors, and other participants at SCCA activities, sessions and social events and when representing SCCA in print or electronic media. In light of this, we kindly request no political solicitation or signage on the premises.

Registration:

1. Event Registration: All participants MUST register online at www.motorsportreg.com.
2. License & proof of membership must be presented at Registration. You are urged to have an Annual Waiver on file at SCCA. Drivers needing license and/or membership confirmation must contact the Registrar no later than 9 PM WEDNESDAY, October 28, 2020; a \$10 fee will be charged for this service. Membership and license issues will not be able to be verified with the SCCA National Office after 5:00 PM CST on Friday night. After that time, the National Office will be closed until Monday morning. If your membership and/or license cannot be verified, you will be required to complete and sign a Statement of Fact Affidavit along with paying a \$100 deposit, of which \$75 is refundable upon verification.
3. Telephone & online entries are not official until the entry form is signed, accepted, and all fees are received. Personal checks, money orders, or cash only will be accepted at the track. A \$50 charge will be assessed on any check returned.

The Chief Registrar will not be responsible for any entries sent that require a signature or special pick up. Checks and credit cards will be accepted at the track.

- Each race group will be limited to 55 cars; after that number is reached entrants will be placed on a waiting list for their respective group.
- Drivers, crew & workers must register before the close of Registration signing an SCCA waiver & issued a wristband. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action against the responsible driver. Wristbands & SCCA photo IDs MUST be worn at all times. You are urged to have an Annual Waiver on file with the SCCA.
- Car Numbers will be issued on a first come first served basis, postmark will be used. Registrar will notify those who do not receive their first choice of car number.
- Cancellations must be in writing, e-mail cancellations are acceptable. Full refunds will be given to those entrants who cancel before 9 PM, Tues., October 27, 2020. A \$50.00 administrative charge will be assessed to cancellations after that date. No refund will be provided for cancellation requests after November 30, 2020. No refunds will be given to any car that turns a wheel on course.
- There will be NO Late Entry Registration until one hour after posted Registration opening times, Friday and Saturday.

Conduct of the Event:

- There will be no waivers on any safety related equipment.
- The Black Flag station for this event will be at Start/Finish and may be at Station 10.
- Class rules for SM2, SMT, SSM, Spec E-30, SPO, SP, SPU, ITE, CFC, CFF, S2, GTA & IT7 are published on <http://www.nediv.com/club-racing/nediv-regional-class-rules> and www.gldscga.com, Sports R (SR) rules are posted on Neohio's website under Regional Only Rules - <https://neohioscca.com/club-racing-rules-update/>.
- Sound level for Nelson Ledges is 103 dbs. Sound reading will be measured on the outside of turn 13.
- The Start/Finish line extends through pit lane and will be used for all Timing and Scoring. A working AMB TRANX 20 Transponder on each car is mandatory. You will not be scored if it is not working properly. Correct transponder number needs to be provided.
- Operation of 2 way radios on the following frequencies is not permitted: 151.625 MHz, 154.570 MHz and 154.600 MHz, these frequencies are for event official use only.
- CONTACT: All on track body contact (including contact during drafting) that causes a car to act erratically and results in a change in position or a car leaving the course will be investigated. All drivers involved must report to the Chief Steward during the 30-minute Impound for their group. Drivers who do not satisfy this requirement will be referred to the Stewards of the Meet.
- PASSES UNDER YELLOW FLAG: All passes under yellow reports will be investigated. All drivers shall follow GCR Section 41B A violation of this section will result in penalties as outline in the 2020 Standard Penalty Guidelines.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in the paddock by anyone until the end of the entire day's find on track race activity.
- Damage to property not covered by SCCA insurance will be back billed to person causing damage.
- A driver not qualifying within a maximum of 115% of the recognized track record of their class must obtain permission from the Chief Steward to race. In the case of unusual circumstances, the Chief Steward can waive this rule.

Track Policies and Services

- Wristbands provided at Registration must be worn at all times. Participants without wristbands will not gain entry or will be asked to leave the track. Drivers will not be allowed on course without the wristband in place and will be checked by the grid marshals. Replacement wristbands are \$10.00.
- Only ONE crew member may stand at the pit wall to signal the driver at the discretion of the Chief of Pits.
- Riding on outside of any vehicle or trailer is prohibited.
- Two, three and four-wheeled vehicles are prohibited, except for race officials or as race support vehicles. No joy riding. Driver must be at least 18 and have a driver's license issued by their home state. All race support vehicles must prominently display the approved racecar number and class.
- Un-muffled engines shall not be operated between 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 am.
- Pets must be restrained AT ALL TIMES & attended by an adult. Clean up after your pet.
- Camping is permitted for a fee specified by track management. Hookups are not available. Campfires must always be contained and attended by an adult at all times. No accelerants may be used.
- Competitors must remove all tires and used automotive fluids from the premises. Please clean your area before departing.
- No testing of race cars off the track premises or side roads.
- Traffic on bridge will be for passenger vehicles only. No auto or foot traffic while cars are on course.
- Motorhomes and semi-trailers owners are requested to contact the track prior to the event for parking locations. 330-977-0111
- Food concession may be available.
