Supplemental Rules

1. Michael 'Doc' Saddleton Memorial Regional Entry Fees: The Entry fee is \$425.00 per driver, Entry Fee for one driver, 2 classes is \$625.00. One Day Regional Entry is \$275.00. Checks are payable to "Mahoning Valley Region, SCCA" in US funds, and include one car, one driver, and three crew passes. Late entries may be charged a handling fee of \$25.00. Over crew passes are \$10.00 each. Please pay for over crew at registration. SRF3/SRF/FE2/FE COMPLIANCE FEE - \$30.00. RETURNED CHECKS - If the bank refuses to honor an entrant's or driver's check for any reason, the Region will assess the entrant or driver a \$50.00 service charge. Failure to make a check good within 10 days of the event may result in suspension of the driver's competition license and membership. Cash, Checks, Credit/Debit Cards accepted at Registration. Online payments are not accepted. **ENTRIES:** Entries are not official until all monies are paid. No phone entries will be accepted after 6 pm on May 18. No refunds once a competitor turns a wheel on track.

All cancellation requests must be in writing. NO EXCEPTIONS.
Full refunds will be given to cancellations received prior to registration opening at 6:00 pm, May 19, 2023. The registrar will not be responsible for any overnight packages that require a signature.

- 2. **REGISTRATION:** Please note registration hours. All Drivers, crew, and workers must register before the close of registration. <u>PASSES WILL NOT BE LEFT AT THE GATE.</u>
- 3. <u>TECH:</u> Competitors are requested to present a current logbook to Tech to obtain a sticker. Scales will not be available.
- 4. <u>TRANSPONDERS:</u> Transponders are mandatory for this event. No transponders will be available for rent.
- 5. PIT LANE EXIT: A light will be used to control pit out in lieu of a flag person.
- 6.SOUND CONTROL: Sound level per the GCR 5.7.3. Sound Control will be outside of turn 13.
- 7. **BLACK FLAG:** The Black Flag Station for this event will be Station 10.
- 8. <u>DRONES:</u> "Unmanned aircraft systems, also known as drones, shall not be used anywhere in the airspace over Nelson Ledges Road Course property. The only exception is a company which has been contracted by Mahoning Valley Region."
- 9. **RESULTS/TROPHIES:** Results will be posted at the base of the the Timing Tower. Trophies awarded per the GCR and may be mailed 10. **IT7 Rules: Improved Touring 7** (Class designation IT7). IT7 includes all first-generation Mazda RX7s prepared to the ITA specifications in the current GCR.

EVENT RULES, PROCEDURES and TRACK RULES

- 1. <u>ELIGIBILITY:</u> This Regional event is open to drivers holding an SCCA Competition or Novice Permit holders or the licenses of any of the approved organizations listed in the GCR 3.1.2, APPC 2.8.1 provided they are SCCA members.
- 2. <u>CREDENTIALS:</u> Per track management, wristbands will be issued at registration and <u>MUST</u> be always visible.
- 3. <u>INJURIES:</u> Injuries to event participants should be reported to race medical. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility for coverage under the SCCA participant accident insurance coverage program.
- 4. FALSE GRID: Spectating from the False Grid is prohibited.
- 5. PIT: NO SMOKING IN THE PITS!! Closed shoes must be worn in the pits. Crews working on cars in the Pits must wear long pants and long-sleeved shirts. Shorts & short sleeved shirts are allowed in the pits.
- 6. **PADDOCK:** Paddock speed is 5mph. Unsafe use of any vehicle is prohibited. Riding on the outside of any vehicle or trailer is prohibited. No two, three or four-wheel recreation vehicles are allowed except for race officials or as race support vehicles.
- 7. <u>NOISE:</u> Absolutely <u>NO</u> running of unmuffled engines between the hours of 8:00pm and 7:30am.
- 8. <u>WASTE:</u> <u>NO</u> tires shall be left by teams. A waste oil drum is located by the fuel pumps. Waste oil disposal is provided by Everclear Inc. No glass containers please.
- 9. RACE CARS OFF-SITE: Using local roads neighboring Nelson Ledges Road Course property for testing of race vehicles subjects them to local laws. Track management does not support such activity

and will assist authorities in enforcement. They will also evict guilty parties from the track and ban them from future events. Please help the track stay friendly with its neighbors by avoiding these types of activities

- 10. <u>RADIOS:</u> Operation of 2-way radios on the following frequencies is <u>NOT PERMITTED</u>: 151.625, 154.600, and 154.570. Scanners are allowed.
- 11. <u>SIGNALING:</u> A maximum of one person per team will be allowed at the outer pit wall for signaling to the driver during practice, qualifying, and the races.
- 12. <u>CAMPING:</u> Camping is permitted at the track for a fee. There are <u>NO ELECTRICAL OR WATER HOOK-UPS.</u> Showers are available.

 13. <u>RACE FUEL:</u> Sunoco110 Octane Leaded and 100 Octane Unleaded race fuel and 93 Octane Unleaded is available at the track.
- 14. **TESTING:** Nelson Ledges Road Course will conduct a non-SCCA sanctioned paid test day on Friday, May 27, 2022. Please contact Nelson Ledges at 330-977-0111. <u>Test & Tune by Kryderacing info on May 19, 2023</u>
- 15. **Mahoning Valley Region, SCCA** reserves the right to cancel this event for any circumstances it deems necessary. It also reserves the right the right to refuse entry for any circumstances it deems necessary.
