REmarks - Reed Kryder

It is time for our Annual Picnic Meeting at Nelson Ledges. It is scheduled for August 7th. Details are found elsewhere in this newsletter. This has become our best attended meeting in recent years. I don't know if it is the ability to take friends around the track, the crazy solo, the hot dogs, or perhaps it's just the great company of fellow enthusiasts. You will need to come and find out for yourself.

On a more serious note, the Mahoning Valley Region has a very special Regional weekend scheduled at Nelson for the weekend of August 4-5. Whether a driver or volunteer, please plan on attending. Your Region managed to finish our National weekend in "the black". That was the ONLY race weekend we avoided "red ink" during the past few years. It would be fantastic if we had two financially successful events. Talk to your friends and encourage their participation.

One way to help is to enter even if you are not positive you will participate. There has been a trend in recent years of waiting for the last minute to enter. The internet has enabled this a lot. People also wait to see the weather forecast. Some wait to see who and how many have entered. The problem with checking to see who has entered is potential entrants get depressed because they don't see their buddy or a sizable entry field. Two years ago we had an event with only 3 Spec Miatas officially entered one week prior to the event. But Sandi had verbal commitments from over a dozen SM drivers. While at another event on the preceding weekend some of these "verbally committed" drivers started to talk about NOT ENTERING BECAUSE THERE WERE SO FEW ENTRIES. Sandi entered every one of them on Monday and all of them (and others) showed up for the MVR race. Please, enter ASAP if you think you might enter.

Continuing along the financial line of thought: If you did not already know, Neohio cancelled their August 18-19 Regional event at Nelson Ledges. They have replaced it with a Time-Trial event on Sunday, Aug. 19. I do not know the details, but I believe it was triggered by money concerns. They would not be the first. A couple of years ago, Western New York ended their long running "Great Pumpkin Affair" Regional when the Region's finances could no longer support it. Across the country there are more Regions operating their events in the "red" than in the "black". Smaller Regions and club level tracks (as opposed to pro-level) are suffering the most. MVR is probably typical of most Regions in that we have seen our treasury gradually shrink over the past several years. While we are still financially okay, we need every entry we can get for every event or we will be facing similar tough decisions in the future.

One other observation. While Regions running at club tracks fight for survival, Regions running at pro tracks fight ever increasing track rental costs. What happens if we can no longer afford the pro circuits while the club circuits have permanently closed their doors? Most of

us are watching every dollar we spend during these financially difficult times. If possible, consider spreading your dollars around.
