REport

Annual elections were held at the October membership meeting and the front page of this newsletter has the new listing.

During the October meeting Assistant RE Brad Morris put forth the idea of having someone handle the race-mvr.org website and similar ("modern") ways of communicating what MVR is doing. The race-mvr site has great potential for members posting photos and comments on what is happening with their cars. While a lot of us will take advantage of the site, we probably would not be as active as those of the younger generation. Brad felt we needed someone of that generation to run the site.

I spent a lot of time thinking about this during a recent trip and found myself often putting the "cart before the horse" in my ideas. What I mean by that is I kept trying to think of how to find young people who understand how to communicate thru websites and then get them interested in MVR. What I (and I include all MVR members) should be doing is finding young people who are interested in MVR and then finding someone amongst that crowd who would like to handle our internet opportunities. Putting the "horse in front of the cart" requires a very different approach. Here are several suggestions:

1. Look within our own circles of co-workers, friends, and relatives. We all have the tendency to communicate with people of our own age, but we should also consider the younger age group.
2. When we conduct a Tire Rack Street Survival we need to be more active at promoting MVR. Granted, we don't want to "push" racing, but we can promote "having safe fun" with cars.
3. Car Shows are a great opportunity to promote MVR activities. While we could do it as a group if the opportunity arose, we should also take advantage of individual opportunities. If you get the chance to display your race car at a show please let us know so we can create some handouts targeting those at the show. And don't forget to target the younger audience as well.
4. Most of us have regular "street rod" type car shows at local watering holes. Stop by sometime and see if there are any "sporty" cars amongst the group. They are usually easy to spot and the fact they are there probably means they are already a gearhead.

These are just a few ideas. I am sure you have others. Let's hear them. I would really appreciate hearing from some of our younger members. I strongly feel it is time to have younger people influencing what MVR does and the direction we will take in the future. I am not against major changes if it means younger people evolving the Region into what they want.

Related to the above is how we treat potential members once they show an interest in MVR. While most of us are very comfortable socializing during dinner and

enjoying a beer or two prior to each membership meeting, is this enough to greet potential members, especially if they are younger than the normal crowd? Maybe inviting them to one of our other functions would have a greater impact.

Hope to see everyone at the November 4th membership meeting. And don't forget the Christmas Party at our December meeting.
