What can we do as a region to entice drivers to enter an event early? The key word is "early". Let's use ten days before the event as a definition of early

As the race chairman & chief registrar for MVR events, it's a frustrating problem. Difficult for planning purposes. Driver's wonder why we do not have trophies at the events any more - one reason is the lead time. We need several weeks. Driver's are waiting until the very last minute to enter, the region does not want an over abundance of trophies left that we have to throw out. Hence - no trophies at the track. You wonder why we do not serve dinners anymore - same reason.

We work hard to "Make it easy, make it fun" at MVR events for the drivers. We do not deposit checks until after the race weekend. We let you pay at registration with VISA, MASTERCARD, DISCOVER, AMERICAN

EXPRESS , DEBIT CARDS along with the preferred cash & checks. We do not charge a cancelation fee. Rarely even charge a late fee. We give the driver money back if he has to cancel out of the second day of a double.

This isn't just a Mahoning Valley problem. It seems to be the trend of the country. A trend I personally would like to see stopped.

Asking drivers to enter early had not produced much of a change. "Late Fees" do not seem to be a workable solution. It is time for some new ideas. Time to think "out of the box". I'm listening.
